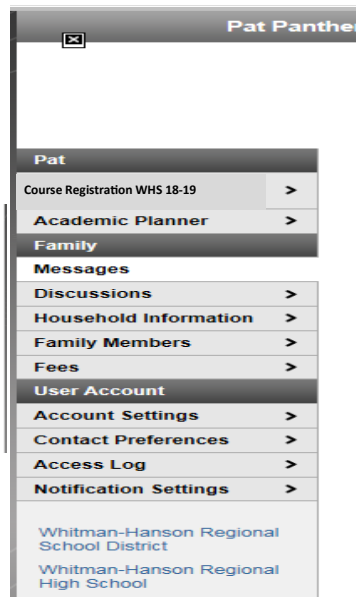
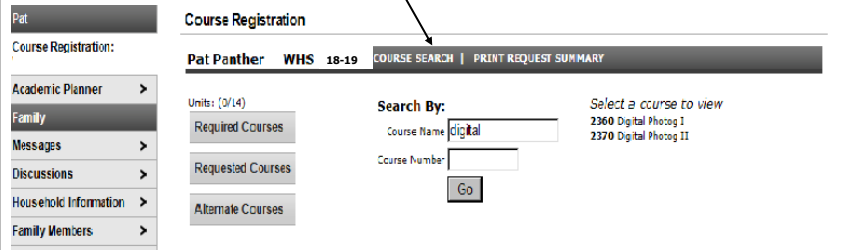
On-line registration for the 2018-2019 school year is available via the Infinite Campus portal from March 9 to March 16, 2018.

Your teachers will be submitting requests for major academic classes directly via Infinite Campus. You will be making course requests for all other classes. To make requests online through Infinite Campus, follow these directions:

- Portal address: www.whrsd.org, then click on Infinite Campus Portal
- Log in with your user name and password. If you need help retrieving either of these, please contact Tech Services.

To Register:

1. Log into your student portal account
2. Click on **“Course Registration: WHS 18-19”** link
3. Click on **“Course Search”**



4. Click **“GO”** to display all available courses. To search for a course, enter course number or the course name (you may enter part of a name).

5. Please check for appropriate grade levels of courses before making your selections. When you find the course you want, select it and click **“Request this Course”**.

2360 DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY I

This course is designed to teach students basic photographic digital process and imaging. In the first half of the course through a variety of assignments, extensive instruction and practice in the technical and historical aspects of photography will be covered. Learning digital camera controls and computer programs such as Adobe PhotoShop will be explored. The second half will place emphasis on photography as a creative communications vehicle and as an art form demonstrating the application and understanding of elements of composition, lighting, and design. The class is open to all students who have a willingness to learn about, as well as do digital photography in a computer lab environment. Students are encouraged to have the use of their own digital camera. This course addresses Whitman-Hanson Student Expectations 1-7.
