



Dear Parents and Guardians,

There have been many changes in the Whitman-Hanson Regional School District's School Lunch Program. One big change occurred during the summer break of 2018 with the addition of the Whitman-Hanson Regional School District's Summer Feeding Program. The Summer Feeding Program is available to all of our Whitman-Hanson Regional School District students PK-12.

What exactly is a Summer Feeding Program? The Whitman-Hanson Regional School District High School Cafeteria will offer a daily Main Meal Menu, along with a choice of a slice of Pizza or Assorted Deli Sandwich's or PB& Jelly Sandwich during each weekday, Monday-Wednesday, from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM daily. The Summer Feeding program will begin on July 8, 2019 and will end on August 2, 2018. Each meal will come with a choice of Fresh Fruit or Chilled Fruit, and a choice of Carrot Sticks or Celery Stick or Cherry tomatoes, assorted bottled Milk or 100% Fruit Juice cups, with each meal. The Main Meal Menu will be posted on the Food Service Web Site. Meals will be served at the Whitman-Hanson High School located at 610 Franklin Street, Whitman, Massachusetts. For our new users, on the first day that you plan on using our program, we ask that you contact us that morning no later than 9:00 AM by phone. You can reach us by phone at (781) 618-7439 or (781) 618-7431. Please ask for Mrs. Thorp or Mrs. Smith. This will help us to plan our meals.

We are offering a Summer Feeding Program to all Whitman-Hanson Families. By eating here at the Whitman-Hanson High School, your child will receive a balanced and healthy lunch meal at a low cost to your family. We welcome all family members to participate. Having a meal together will also be a great way to connect and meet with other students during the summer break. You can eat here inside the cafeteria, or you may take your meals to go to have a picnic lunch.

All Whitman-Hanson Regional School District students PK-12 are welcome. The cost for Meals will be the same cost as during the school year. Full priced meals will cost \$3.00. Reduced price meals will cost \$.40. There will be no charge (\$.00) for students receiving Free Meal Benefits. All students' that are currently receiving Meal Benefits during the school year will continue the process during the summer program. If you are new to the Meal Benefit program, we will be happy to assist you while applying for new Meal Benefits.

You can pay for your child's meals by using cash, a check, or your child can use their student's Pre-Paid meal account. If you are paying by check, all checks must be made out to: School Lunch. Helpful tips regarding your MyPaymentsPlus Student Meal Account

❖ **Setting up Low-Balance E-mail Notifications & Auto Payments online:**

- 1.) Log-in to your account at: www.MyPaymentsPlus.com
- 2.) Each of the customized settings have a button pertaining to that setting



- 3.) By clicking either the Low-Balance Notifications button or the Auto-Pay button, you will then enter the dollar amount that you want to outline as the "lowest amount" your student's account will hit before a low-balance e-mail notification or auto-payment is processed.
- 4.) If your school offers both Meal *and* General accounts for their cafeteria deposits, be sure to click the box for the desired account in which you are referring to. (As a reminder, Meal accounts allow for one plated meal per lunch/breakfast, whereas the General account enables the student to eat multiple meals and a la carte options.)
- 5.) Be sure to click "**Save Changes**" when you are finished.
