Class will run **Monday through Thursday** and there will be two sessions daily. Students do not have a choice as to which session their course is offered.

### ATTENDANCE POLICY

***Students are expected to attend all classes.***

- Absences from class are limited to two (2) days. **The third absence results in course failure.**
- Tardiness greater than 15 minutes will be considered the equivalent to one absence.
- Two occurrences of less than 15 minutes will equal one absence.
- Two dismissals from class will equal one absence.

### **Courses Offered:**

**The following courses will be taught by a certified teacher:**

- English I/Freshman English
- English II/Sophomore English
- English III/Junior English
- English IV/Senior English
- Algebra II
- Geometry

**\*All other classes will be taught on-line using Edgenuity. There will be a teacher present to facilitate the online classes.**



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## SCHOOL RULES

**All rules that pertain to the regular school year will apply to summer school.**

- Whitman-Hanson is a smoke-free environment, both inside the building and on the grounds.
- Students referred to the Summer School Director for disruptive behavior in class more than two times will be withdrawn from class.
- Parents and students should be aware that serious violations will result in expulsion from summer school.
- Students withdrawn from a class will not be eligible for a tuition refund.

### **ATTENDANCE: (THE ATTENDANCE POLICY IS VERY STRICT...PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)**

*Absences from class are limited to two days. The third absence results in failure. Tardiness greater than 15 minutes will be considered the equivalent of one absence. If a student accumulates two tardies (both are less than 15 minutes each) this will equal one absence. Two dismissals are equal to one absence.*

***For example**, if John has two absences and gets one additional tardy or one additional absence, he will be removed from summer school. **Another example**, if Jill has 2 tardies and 1 absence and gets either one additional tardy or one additional absence, she will be removed from summer school. **A final example**, if Jeff has 4 tardies (all less than 15 minutes each) and accumulates either one additional tardy or one additional absence, he will be removed from summer school.*

- *If students have combinations of tardiness, dismissals, and absences that exceed the limit of two absences they will be removed from summer school.*
- *Students referred to the Summer School Director for disruptive behavior in class more than two times will be withdrawn from class*
- *Each time a student is removed from a class due to disruptive behavior counts as one absence.*

### **GRADES:**

*On a weekly basis, students will be issued progress reports. The reports **must** be signed by a parent/guardian, and returned to the issuing teacher.*

### **STUDENT REGULATIONS AND BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS:**

*All regulations for student conduct that pertain to the school year will also apply to the Summer School program. The following should be noted, because they constitute grounds for expulsion from summer school:*

- *Over use of absences, excessive tardiness, or excessive dismissals*
- *Disruption of classes or school*
- *Smoking anywhere on school grounds*
- *Fighting, hazing, or harassment*
- *Use or possession of drugs or alcohol*
- *Use of electronic devices, including cell phones, during class*
- *Leaving school without permission*
- *Loitering or being in an unauthorized area*
- *Failure to respond to a reasonable request from a staff member*
- *Use of profanity or vulgarity toward other students or faculty*
- *Cheating or plagiarism are grounds for dismissal*
- *Students are only allowed on the floor where the classes are scheduled and should not be in other parts of the building*
- *Any other disruptive or inappropriate acts judged serious by the Summer School Director*



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*Students are enrolled for the purpose of making up one year's worth of academic work. Appropriate behavior at all times is required. Any student who violates the rules will be removed from the program. THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF TUITION IF REMOVED FROM THE PROGRAM FOR ANY DISCIPLINARY REASONS.*
