Community

Whitman-Hanson Regional High School serves the towns of Whitman (population 14,195) and Hanson (population 9,656), which are residential communities located approximately 27 miles south of Boston. Whitman borders the city of Brockton.

School Information

Whitman-Hanson Regional High School is a comprehensive school, grades 9-12, which is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. The school offers preparation for college and includes elective courses in business & technology, communications, fine arts & music, and culinary arts. Students who wish to concentrate on vocational preparation may attend South Shore Vocational Technical High School. Whitman-Hanson may be reached by traveling Route 18 south or Route 24 south to Route 27 east, along which the school is located.

School Program

The program provides a college preparatory curriculum. Honors, advanced placement, and independent study courses are available, and a special needs program provides a variety of services for students who need them. Advanced Placement courses are offered in English Literature, English Language, Psychology, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics, US History, European History, US Government, Computer Science, Calculus, Spanish, and Statistics.

For the class of 2017, 104 credits are required for graduation. Additional graduation requirements are as follows:
